

# Global Outreach Training Program: Worker Information

*The Global Outreach Training Program offers occupational safety and health training to workers in locations worldwide and online. Through this program, Global OSHA Authorized Trainers conduct introductory and intermediate level classes for workers. These classes focus on the awareness, identification, recognition, and avoidance of safety and health hazards in the workplace. Workers are able to document the training they receive through course completion cards, which contain a link to their Global OSHA digital badges. These digital badges identify the specific training topics completed.*

## International Reach

The Global Outreach Training Program was created to meet the ongoing demand for high quality occupational safety and health training for workers in locations outside the United States. All Global OSHA programs and courses are available to be conducted worldwide.

Developed by former senior management staff from the OSHA Directorate of Training and Education, the program offers the same hazard recognition topics as the U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL) Outreach Training Program, but with greater flexibility.

## One-Day and Three-Day Courses

The #100 series of introductory worker courses are eight hours in length. The #200 series of intermediate courses are 24 hours in length. Courses include the following.

- #100 Introductory Construction Worker Safety
- #101 Introductory General Worker Safety
- #102 Introductory Healthcare Worker Safety
- #103 Introductory Distribution & Delivery Worker Safety
- #104 Introductory Public Sector Worker Safety
- #108 Introductory Manufacturing Worker Safety
- #200 Intermediate Construction Worker Safety
- #201 Intermediate General Worker Safety

## Key Advantages for Global Program

The Global Outreach Training Program offers key advantages for trainers vs. the USDOL Outreach Training Program.

- Trainers can conduct courses in locations worldwide. (USDOL program limited to US-only)
- Courses can be conducted in one day. (USDOL program minimum 2 days)
- Course completion card issued within 30 days. (USDOL program 90 days)
- Content focused solely on hazard recognition topics. (USDOL program includes policy and legal topics)
- Global OSHA classes include digital badges. (USDOL program does not)

- Participants receive high quality training on safety and health hazard recognition and avoidance.
- Training is based on OSHA programs and courses; developed by former senior OSHA personnel.
- Some courses may offer professional development opportunities, including Continuing Education Units (CEUs).
- Update training is required after five years. This ensures that the worker has received current safety training.
- Some training courses are available in Spanish to meet organizational needs.

## Digital Badges

Global OSHA issues digital badges for all training classes because it understands the importance of documenting worker knowledge, skills, and training; especially when it comes to occupational safety and health.

## Course Completion Cards & QR Codes


Global OSHA issues completion cards wallet cards for many of its courses. This includes all #100 and #200 series courses, as well as all trainer courses. The cards contain an ID photo and a QR code which links to the digital badges earned by the cardholder. This allows the cardholder to provide verification of training history, including specific training topics.
