### Global OSHA

*The Global Occupational Safety and Health Academy, LLC (Global OSHA) is founded and managed by former senior management staff from the OSHA Directorate of Training and Education. The organizational mission is to provide a framework for developing and delivering high quality occupational safety and health training to workers around the world. This mission is achieved by conducting instructor-led and online training courses; authorizing affiliate training organizations to offer Global OSHA training programs and courses; and authorizing Global OSHA Authorized Trainers to conduct introductory and intermediate level worker courses at locations worldwide.*

#### International Reach

The Global Occupational Safety and Health Academy was created to meet the ongoing demand for high quality occupational safety and health training for safety professionals and workers in locations around the world.

The programs offered by Global OSHA include the Global OSHA Training Center Program and the Global Outreach Training Program. These programs are modeled after the U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL) OSHA Training Institute (OTI) Education Center Program and Outreach Training Program offered through the USDOL. However, these USDOL programs are only authorized to be conducted within OSHA's geographic jurisdiction. All Global OSHA programs and courses are available to be conducted worldwide.

#### Global OSHA Training Centers

Global OSHA aligns with a select number of affiliate training organizations to act as Global OSHA Training Centers worldwide. These organizations conduct Global OSHA trainer courses. The Global OSHA Training Centers also conduct various occupational safety and health courses for safety professionals.

#### Global Outreach Training Program

The Global Outreach Training Program is modeled after the USDOL OSHA Outreach Training Program, but there are several significant differences between the two programs. These include the course delivery, course training content, and course completion documentation. The Global Outreach Training Program offers the same hazard recognition topics as the USDOL Outreach Training Program, but offers greater flexibility for training locations, more robust training credentials, targeted programs, and no training topics related to policy or legal matters.

#### Trainer Courses

Global OSHA offers trainer course for Construction Safety and General Safety. Prospective trainers must demonstrate three years of safety experience, complete an eight-hour prerequisite course, and complete a three-day Train-the-Trainer course.

#### OSHA Trainer Equivalency

Currently authorized USDOL Outreach Trainers may qualify by completing only the eight-hour prerequisite course, #550 *Fundamentals of Adult Training*. This course is only available online through Global OSHA.

## Online Courses Available

Global OSHA conducts many courses online. Students can earn a Global OSHA course completion wallet card from anywhere in the world. These introductory eight-hour courses provide basic instruction on health hazard awareness, identification, recognition, and avoidance; each includes a bonus safety orientation module. Online courses include:

- #100 Introductory Construction Worker Safety
- #101 Introductory General Worker Safety
- #102 Introductory Healthcare Worker Safety
- #103 Introductory Distribution & Delivery Worker Safety
- #104 Introductory Public Sector Worker Safety
- #108 Introductory Manufacturing Worker Safety

## Global OSHA Training Topics

Training topics include, but are not limited to, the following.

- Fall Hazards/Working at Height
- Electrical Hazards
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Lockout Tagout
- Caught-In or Between, Struck-By Hazards
- Safety and Health Programs

## Digital Badges

Global OSHA issues digital badges for all training classes because it understands the importance of documenting worker training; especially when it comes to occupational safety and health. Global OSHA includes a QR code which links to the badges on all course completion wallet cards for the #100 and #200 series courses, and all trainer cards. This enables the cardholder to share the QR code through the convenience of a wallet-size card which can be scanned and viewed on a job site.

## Contract and Customized Training

Global OSHA conducts a wide range of occupational safety and health courses for safety professionals and workers. Global OSHA offers its regular courses or customized courses on a contract basis to companies and organizations worldwide. Global OSHA can provide training on safety and health topics specific to an organization's industry, or personnel. Global OSHA instructional staff includes safety experts, most of whom are former OSHA personnel or former instructors for the OSHA Training Institute.
