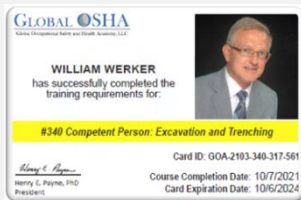

#340 Competent Person: *Excavation and Trenching*

Course Description

OSHA Standard 1926 Subpart P – Excavations includes multiple provisions that require a competent person for excavation worksites. This is defined as an individual capable of identifying existing and predictable hazards in the surroundings, or working conditions which are unsanitary, hazardous, or dangerous to employees, and who has authorization to take prompt corrective measures to eliminate them.

This course provides instruction for participants to be able to recognize and abate hazards related to excavation and trenching such as collapses and cave-ins. Instruction consists of live webinar presentation and discussion which provide a complete overview of the related hazards and abatement methods. Students complete self-paced knowledge checks in the LMS and must pass a written exam to earn this credential.



This course provides introductory level safety and health training for workers. Additional training may be needed in the hazards related to an industry or a specific work site.
