## Course Description

This training is intended for individuals responsible for the investigation and/or assessment of workplace accidents and/or near-miss scenarios. This includes safety managers or officers, occupational health and safety specialists or technicians, and risk management personnel.

This course consists of **live presentation** and discussion via Zoom Webinar. Students also complete **self-paced knowledge checks** in the LMS.

## Course Topics

Include accident investigation purpose and planning; investigation team roles and responsibilities; preparing an investigation kit; investigative process; preserving and documenting the scene; accident analysis techniques; developing the event sequence; root cause analysis; causation models; Fishbone diagrams; organizational factors; accident reconstruction; witness accounts and interviewing techniques; incident records; developing accident investigation reports; legal aspects; and implementing appropriate follow-up actions.

Students must pass a written exam and a practical exam in order to pass the course and earn the authorization. **Contact hours: 8, CEUs: 0.8**

## Course Documents

Upon successful completion of this course, students earn a Global OSHA course completion certificate, a Global OSHA Course Completion wallet card with embedded digital badge, and 0.8 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) to document their training.

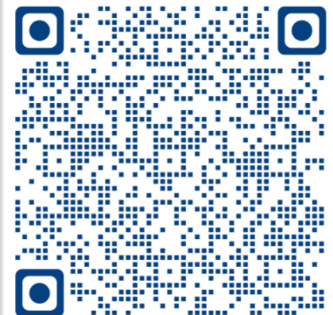
